Interns

Young designers join us for 3-6 months of training in design, serving the poor, and pursuing God.

Volunteer Professionals

Experienced professionals form a project team for one week on a design trip and then coordinate to finish design work from their homes.



Project Leaders

Volunteer staff work full time with eMi² to assemble project teams, lead design trips, and produce project reports.

Christian NGOs

Organizations such as hospitals, schools and orphanages implement our designs to extend their reach to the poor.



High quality engineering and architectural design is an unaffordable luxury for Christian development organizations striving to aid the poor. Responding to that need, eMi² challenges technical designers to apply their expertise and effort free of charge to organizations who serve the poor.



servicing

Project leaders direct cross-cultural volunteer and intern teams through one-week site visits to Christian NGOs. These teams of 5-10 professionals come together to use their technical skills to serve the poor of India and South Asia. They first research local construction methods and materials, assess future development needs, and survey properties; then they design master plans, buildings and water systems. Finally leaders, volunteers, and interns deliver sets of detailed designs to NGOs, which can be submitted to local building authorities and constructed by local contractors. When interns and volunteers are available for longer commitments, eMi² can send on-site representatives to assist NGOs by advising builders, masons, and contractors.
